### Water wells in Kenya!

2010 started off with a bang. Bobby and I were in Kenya in January and had been on the ground for 2 weeks when Well Aware called and said they were ready to drill the well for the women's center in Oltinga. A week later I came home and left Bobby there to meet the Well Aware team and get the drilling done. What an amazing well it turned out to be! 60 gpm when they had expected somewhere around 30 gpm. 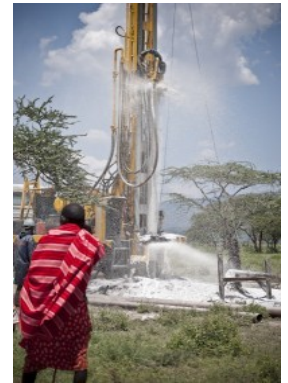
God be the glory.

The property in Namanga has now been finalized in the name of Kingdom Drilling which is now an NGO in Kenya. The children in the Rescue Homes are also under this umbrella. The children are all fine and send their love to you all. Thank you for continuing to support them and give them rescue from the slums.

The next drilling project will be the well in Namanga for the banana farm. The proceeds from the bananas will fund

## 2010 Goals

2010 should be an interesting year for Feed The Kingdom. We have a well to put in on the Namanga property as well as bananas to plant. The children in the Rescue Homes want to move to the property and the work has already begun. Brio and the Well Aware gang took

a chainsaw with them to Kenya in January and Bobby and Mike Muge have already begun to clear the Acacia trees to make the charcoal. The charcoal will be sold and the proceeds should pay for the fence around the property as well as any additional funds

needed to put in the water well and or plant bananas. Then the first crop of bananas should be harvested within 8 months. So by year's end we are praying the well is in, the bananas are planted and waiting for the harvest!
